Industrial Sewing Certificate increases income by 625%

One of the best paid trade jobs in the Guatemala City area is industrial sewing. Just check the tag on your favorite Target shirt. Once certified as seamstresses through CADA these women are able to compete for some of the best wages in the labor sector. Increasing their income by 625% (from \$60 to \$375/mo) means their kids can go to school! This is transformative for families seeking to break the cycle of generational poverty. The New CADA Women's Center - Guatemala City

In April we were so excited to finally launch a new women's empowerment ministry in Guatemala City with Convoy of Hope and Vida Assembly of God. The Spanish word CADA means "every" and the CADA women's center is committed to serving every woman through spiritual development, personal mentoring, and vocational training. Covid restrictions currently limit our attendance to 40 women, but we plan to increase to 80 by next year! Women from all walks of life participate in our training programs. Many women in Latin America do not have the opportunity to receive a formal education or learn a valuable trade. At CADA, women learn more than just about how to beautify the outside of a person. It's funny to think that the greatest lesson to be learned in our cosmetology workshops is to never judge by appearances.


Pray for the Amazing Women of CADA!
